Dear Mr. Char;

I am in receipt of your letter of March 5th, asking about our performances. Our regular performances are given on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday, but if, due to your schedule, you would prefer a Monday night performance, we shall be happy to arrange a special showing for you.

I can quote you a price of \$2.50 per person for those 25 persons making up your party. You and any staff members you may have with you will be our guests. The total price for the party of 25 would be \$62.50 or, if you wish to pay in our local currency, 1250 ticals.

Do you wish me to arrange transportation to and from your hotel? You did not mention this, but as I remember, I arranged transportation for you the last time you were here.

I am sending this letter to Hong Kong because I feel it would not reach Tokyo in time. I trust the above arrangements will be satisfactory. Please let me know which night you prefer, as I shall need a few days to arrange the special Monday night performance if you wish it on that night.
